[Attorneys who are members of The Florida Bar are permitted to bring electronic equipment into the Courthouse upon presentation of their Florida Bar card.] **Please note, members of the public, including non-attorney parties, are not permitted to bring in electronic equipment of any kind absent a Court order.**
