**ORDER VACATING CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER
AND VACATING THE MARCH 27, 2014, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*Adams*) on January 29, 2014. Prior to expiration of that order's 7-day stay of transmittal, plaintiff in *Adams* filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer. Plaintiff later filed a motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. The Panel has now been informed that *Adams* was remanded the District Court of Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, by the Honorable Robin J. Cauthron in an order filed on March 6, 2014.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Panel's conditional transfer order designated as "CTO-207" filed on January 29, 2014, is VACATED.
