ORDER DENYING REMAND

Before the Panel:^{*} Plaintiffs in 71 actions (listed on Schedule A), which we previously transferred from fourteen districts to MDL No. 2325, move under Panel Rule 10.3 for an order remanding their actions to their transferor courts. Responding defendant American Medical Systems, Inc. (AMS) opposes the motion to vacate.

After considering the argument of counsel, we conclude that remand is not appropriate at this time, and therefore deny plaintiffs' motion. In considering the question of Section 1407 remand, we accord great weight to the transferee judge's determination that remand of a particular action at a particular time is appropriate, given that he or she has supervised the day-to-day pretrial proceedings in the MDL. *See In re: Holiday Magic Sec. & Antitrust Litig.*, 433 F. Supp. 1125, 1126 (J.P.M.L. 1977). The transferee judge's suggestion of remand to the Panel, *see* Panel Rule 10.1(b), is obviously an indication that he or she perceives his role under Section 1407 to have ended. *See In re: Columbia/HCA Healthcare Corp. Qui Tam Litig. (No. II)*, 560 F. Supp. 2d 1349, 1350 (J.P.M.L. 2008). Here, Judge Joseph R. Goodwin of the Southern District of West Virginia has not issued such a suggestion. Without a suggestion of remand, a party advocating Section 1407 remand "bears a strong burden of persuasion." *In re: Holiday Magic*, 433 F. Supp. at 1126.

In requesting remand, plaintiffs argue that common discovery in these actions is complete, and that it would be more appropriate for the transferor courts to address remaining common pretrial motions. Plaintiffs have not met their burden of showing that pretrial proceedings are essentially complete, or that continued centralization would not serve the convenience of the parties and witnesses or promote the just and efficient conduct of the litigation. Several common pretrial motions remain unresolved, and absent an indication from the transferee judge, we cannot conclude that they would be more efficiently addressed by the transferor courts.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion for Section 1407 remand of these actions is denied.
