**ORDER VACATING CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER  
AND VACATING THE JANUARY 25, 2018, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*Karn*) on October 19, 2017. Prior to expiration of that order's 7-day stay of transmittal, plaintiffs in *Karn* filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer. Plaintiffs later filed a motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. Plaintiffs state that the parties have reached an agreement in principle to settle an inventory of cases, including the instant case. No party has opposed the motion to vacate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiffs' unopposed motion to vacate is GRANTED, and the Panel's conditional transfer order designated as "CTO-236" filed on October 19, 2017, is VACATED. The parties are instructed to notify the Panel immediately if settlement in this matter is not finalized.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hearing Session Order and the attached Schedule filed on December 15, 2017, are VACATED insofar as they relate to this matter.
