**ORDER VACATING CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER
AND VACATING THE NOVEMBER 29, 2012, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*DeLeon*) on September 25, 2012. Prior to expiration of that order's 7-day stay of transmittal, plaintiff in *DeLeon* filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer. Plaintiff later filed a motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. The Panel has now been informed that *DeLeon* was remanded to the 93rd District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas, by the Honorable Micaela Alvarez in an order filed on October 25, 2012.
