**ORDER DEEMING MOTION MOOT
AND VACATING THE OCTOBER 2, 2014, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

Before the Panel is a motion, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407, by plaintiffs Chip-Tech, Ltd., and Dependable Component Supply Corp., seeking transfer of the actions on the attached schedule to the Northern District of California, for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings.
