**ORDER DEEMING MOTION WITHDRAWN
AND VACATING THE MAY 28, 2015, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

Before the Panel is a motion by plaintiffs/relators Patricia Salazar, Brian Payne, Christi Hays, Mamie Andrews and Carolina Marion, filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407. In their motion, plaintiffs seek centralization of the actions on the attached schedule in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California or, in the alternative, the Central District of California for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings.
