**ORDER DEEMING MOTION MOOT
AND VACATING THE NOVEMBER 30, 2017, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

Before the Panel is a motion filed by defendant Nestle Waters North America, Inc., seeking centralization of the actions on the attached schedule, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407, in the United States District Court of the District of Connecticut for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings. The Panel has now been advised that the listed *Ray* action was transferred to the District of Connecticut, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1404, by the Honorable John A. Woodcock, Jr., in an order filed on November 19, 2017, thus depriving this litigation of its multidistrict character.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hearing Session Order and the attached Schedule filed on October 17, 2017, are VACATED insofar as they relate to this matter.
