COURTHOUSE ADVISORY NOTICE

U.S. DISTRICT COURT FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF NORTH CAROLINA

USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN THE COURTHOUSE

Counsel appearing for oral argument before the Panel may bring cell phones, laptop computers, and similar devices into the courthouse after they have been screened by court security. Such devices will be allowed in the courtroom so long as they do not either disrupt the hearing session or pose a security threat. Cell phone calls cannot be either made from or answered in the courtroom or used to record or transmit court proceedings. Unless otherwise permitted by Local Rules, all such devices must be powered off in the courtroom. Identification such as a bar card will streamline the screening process by court security.
