**COURTHOUSE ADVISORY NOTICE**

**U.S. DISTRICT COURT FOR THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF WISCONSIN**

**USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN THE COURTHOUSE**

Counsel appearing for oral argument before the Panel may bring cell phones and laptop computers into the courthouse, such devices will be allowed in the courtroom so long as they do not either disrupt the hearing session or pose a security threat. Cell phone calls cannot be either made from or answered in the courtroom, used to record or transmit court proceedings. All such devices must be turned off or silenced. General public must adhere to the same protocols.
