
**ORDER VACATING CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER
AND VACATING THE SEPTEMBER 25, 2025, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*Marathon Petroleum*) on July 10, 2025. Prior to expiration of that order's 7-day stay of transmittal, plaintiffs filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer order. Plaintiffs later filed a motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. The Panel has been informed that the action was remanded to the Superior Court of Skagit County, Washington, by the Honorable Marsha J. Pechman on September 3, 2025.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Panel's conditional transfer order designated as "CTO-266" filed on July 10, 2025, is VACATED insofar as it relates to this action.
