**ORDER LIFTING STAY OF CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER
AND VACATING THE MAY 30, 2024, HEARING SESSION ORDER**

A conditional transfer order was filed in this action (*Chester*) on March 26, 2024. Prior to expiration of that order's 7-day stay of transmittal, plaintiff *Chester* filed a notice of opposition to the proposed transfer order. Plaintiff later filed the required motion and brief to vacate the conditional transfer order. Plaintiff has withdrawn his opposition to transfer.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the stay of the Panel's conditional transfer order designated as "CTO-8" filed on March 26, 2024, is LIFTED insofar as it relates to this action. This action is transferred to the Northern District of California for inclusion in the coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings under 28 U.S.C. § 1407 being conducted by the Honorable Beth Labson Freeman.
