
**ORDER ADOPTING RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE UNITED STATES JUDICIAL
PANEL ON MULTIDISTRICT LITIGATION
AND RULES FOR MULTICIRCUIT PETITIONS FOR REVIEW**

On December 19, 2025, the Panel gave public notice of proposed amendments to the Rules of Procedure of the United States Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation and the Rules for Multicircuit Petitions for Review. In addition to posting on the Panel's website, notice was sent to all district and circuit court judges and staff, as well as to all counsel registered with the Panel's CM/ECF. The public and the judiciary were invited to submit comments on the proposed amendments by February 2, 2026. One comment was received, which the Panel has considered. The Panel will adopt the proposed amendments in their entirety.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407(f) and 28 U.S.C. § 2112(a), the Rules of Procedure of the United States Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation and the Rules for Multicircuit Petitions for Review are amended as set forth in the document attached hereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these amended Rules shall be effective on February 19, 2026.
